



and lead us not into temptation,





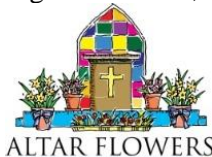
